- PSY 6191 is a special topics course that explores various psychology subjects. It is eligible for credit only for students in the MA in PSC program when it focuses on the field of psychedelics.
- PSY 6442 designates the fieldwork courses offered on-location during the fall and winter breaks, as well as in the spring.
